



Policy on school uniform – 2024 FOUNDATION PHASE (GRADE R – 3)

PREAMBLE

Subject to the South African Schools Act 84 of 1996 Section 20(1), the School Governing Body (SGB) of a public-school MUST –

- (a) promote the best interests of the school and strive to ensure its development through the provision of quality education for ALL learners at the school;
- (b) adopt a Code of Conduct for learners of the school

The Fields College Learner Code of Conduct ensures that teaching and learning occurs in a tension-free, academic environment where courteous, well-disciplined learners demonstrate respect for one another, for all staff and any visitors at the school. It is critical that teaching time not be impacted upon by dealing with avoidable issues regarding uniform non-compliance.

1. APPEARANCE

A learner who does not comply with our policy will be warned and given appropriate opportunity to swiftly correct the infringement. Parents will be informed via SMS or phone call. Should the learner still not comply, this will constitute a breach of the Code of Conduct and disciplinary action will be taken. The school uniform must always be clean and neat. No unauthorized pieces of clothing are allowed with the school uniform.
